EMERGING THEMES: LSS

From the community:

- Preference changed over the course of the consultation process
 - Originally: HDS/Simonds Option
 - Later in process: Partial Replacement of LSS
- High value for the school, staff and programs
- Lack of strong desire for the Brookswood option
- Lack of strong desire to seismically upgrade current LSS

BUSINESS CASE

Documentation of four options provided

- Option 1: Seismic upgrading of LSS; new school in Willoughby
- Option 2: Re-establish HD Stafford as a secondary school; new school in Willoughby
- Option 3: Expand Brookswood; new school in Willoughby
- Option 4: Partial replacement of LSS; new school in Willoughby

NEXT STEPS

- Submit business case to the Ministry of Education
- Begin planning with the communities
