On February 17, 2015, the Langley Board of Education approved submitting to the Ministry of Education a business case requesting that a new secondary school be built in the Willoughby community.

This recommendation was a result of the recent consultation process in which the RE Mountain family of schools participated. The School District and Board of Education appreciate all individuals who took the time to provide feedback and be part of the process.

The District will now submit a business case to the Ministry of Education and await a response. Once this information is available it will be communicated to schools. In the meantime, the District will meet with the community to prepare a transition plan as well as interim measures in order to best accommodate students in Willoughby schools. This information will be forthcoming from your schools.

As a result, the District is committed to moving forward in the years ahead. I will be working with your community to co-create a plan that best meets the needs of your children.
